After discussion it was resolved to defer further consideration to the next Meeting.

Towcester Fire Brigade A letter from the Towcester Fire Brigade demanding an annual contribution of £2.10.0 was ordered to be laid upon the table.

Ac/s The Annual Accounts, Receipts & Bank Book were duly examined and passed.
